Dear Interested Parties:

A copy of a request for recognition petition (Petition) pursuant to PERB Regulation 51030<sup>1</sup> was received by the Public Employment Relations Board (PERB or Board) on May 24, 2021, from Student Researchers United, UAW. The Petition is for a proposed unit of graduate students employed with the Regents of the University of California as researchers, trainees, and fellows.

The petitioner and/or PERB records indicate that no employee organization is currently recognized or certified as the exclusive representative of any of the employees in the proposed unit.

Pursuant to PERB Regulations, the employer is hereby requested to:

- I. Post at the worksite(s) at which employees in the proposed unit are employed an executed copy of the Notice of Request for Recognition (reverse side of PERB-4105) along with a copy of the Petition as soon as possible but in no event later than 10 calendar days following the employer's receipt of the Petition. (PERB Regulation 51035.) The Notice must remain posted for 15 workdays. A copy of the notice must be sent to PERB concurrent with its posting.

Pursuant to PERB Regulation 32111, the employer must also provide a copy of the Notice and Petition to all employees in the proposed unit via electronic mail, intranet, internet site, or other electronic means customarily used by the employer to communicate with employees in the proposed unit.

2. File<sup>2</sup> a written statement with PERB within 10 days of service of this letter which:
  - a. Indicates the date the Petition was filed with the employer.
  - b. Confirms or refutes the above information regarding the existence of an exclusive representative.
  - c. Provides a description of the employer's compliance with the requirement of electronic notice to employees.

A copy of the statement must be concurrently served on all interested parties. Service and proof of service pursuant to PERB Regulation 32140 are required.

3. File with PERB within 20 calendar days of service of this letter a list of names of all persons employed in the proposed unit as of the last date of the payroll

period ending prior to May 24, 2021. This list must be in alphabetical order and should include class codes and job titles or classifications. The date used to establish the list and the total number of names on the list should also be included. (PERB Regulation 51050.)

The list of employees provided by the employer will be used to check the sufficiency of the proof of support submitted by the petitioner. All parties will be advised in writing when a proof of support determination has been made.
