I write to ask the University of California (UC) to accept the California Public Employment Relations Board's (PERB) decision related to the recognition of Student Researchers United – UAW, who submitted a majority number of authorization cards to PERB in May.

As a UC alumnus, I know student researchers are an essential part of UC's mission. I understand UC's argument is that a subsect of the 17,000-member bargaining unit may not qualify as employees under the state's Higher Education Employer-Employee Relations Act because they are compensated with external funding, despite performing essentially the same duties within the university system. I am hopeful that PERB will help all parties find an amicable solution, providing student researchers with the rights to which they are entitled, uplifting everyone who contributes to UC's stellar reputation in research and academia.
